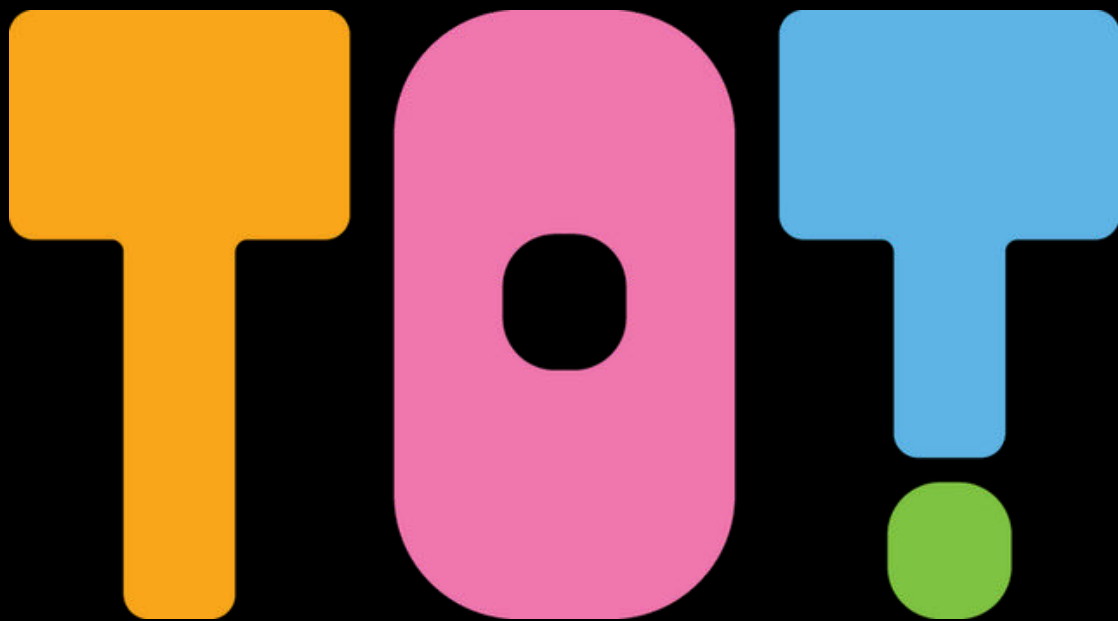

Creative Writing Workshops with Story Studios

Australia
