Exhibition celebrating the full story of Australian music – from pub rock to hip hop, Kylie to Archie Roach. Interactive listening zones, iconic costumes and a 360-degree immersive Amplifier experience.

Sovereign Hill

 Bradshaw St, Ballarat |  Ticketed

An open-air living museum where Ballarat's 1850s gold rush comes to life through costumed characters, working trades and real gold panning.

Discovery Centre Bendigo

 Bendigo |  Ticketed

A hands-on science and technology centre in a heritage railway goods shed. Over 100 interactive exhibits, a Planetarium, a 7-metre vertical slide and special holiday programs.

Central Deborah Gold Mine

Descend 61 metres underground into the tunnels of a real gold mine that operated through the gold rush era. On the surface, explore heritage buildings and do gold panning.

Mornington Peninsula Regional Gallery

Large public gallery with a strong program of Australian art and regular activities for kids and families. Guided tours on Saturday and Sunday afternoons.

Shepparton Art Museum (SAM)

A beautifully purpose-built gallery housing one of Australia's largest ceramic art collections, a growing Indigenous art collection and children's gallery.

Golden Dragon Museum

The story of Chinese Australians in the goldfields and home to one of the world's oldest imperial processional dragons, Chinese gardens and a temple.

McClelland Sculpture Park + Gallery

A unique outdoor art experience where kids can roam among giant sculptures, then warm up inside the gallery or grab a treat at the café. Free entry to the parklands.

Warburton Redwood Forest

📍 Cement Creek Road, Warburton

Wander through towering Californian redwoods and explore the Yarra River trails nearby for a magical winter forest adventure.

Ballarat Wildlife Park

📍 York Street, Ballarat

A family favourite for wildlife lovers, this compact zoo offers hands-on experiences with kangaroos, reptiles, and meerkats. The crisp winter air makes it perfect for exploring without the summer heat.
