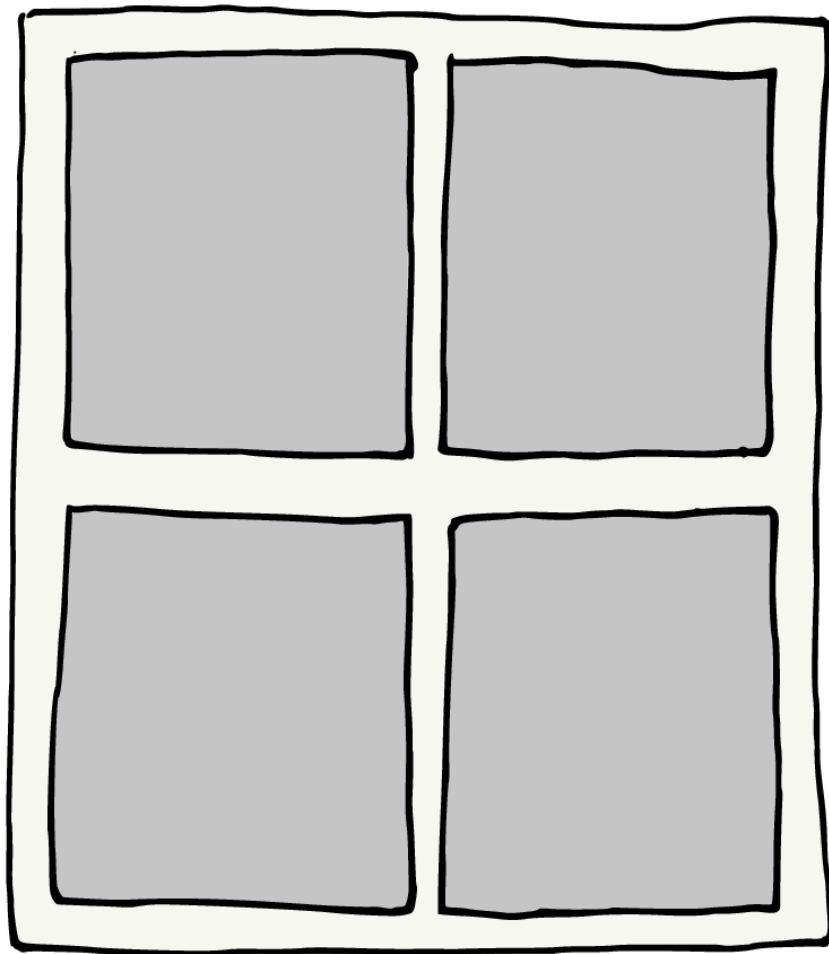


Myer Christmas Windows 2024

It's where the Irwin family live and work.

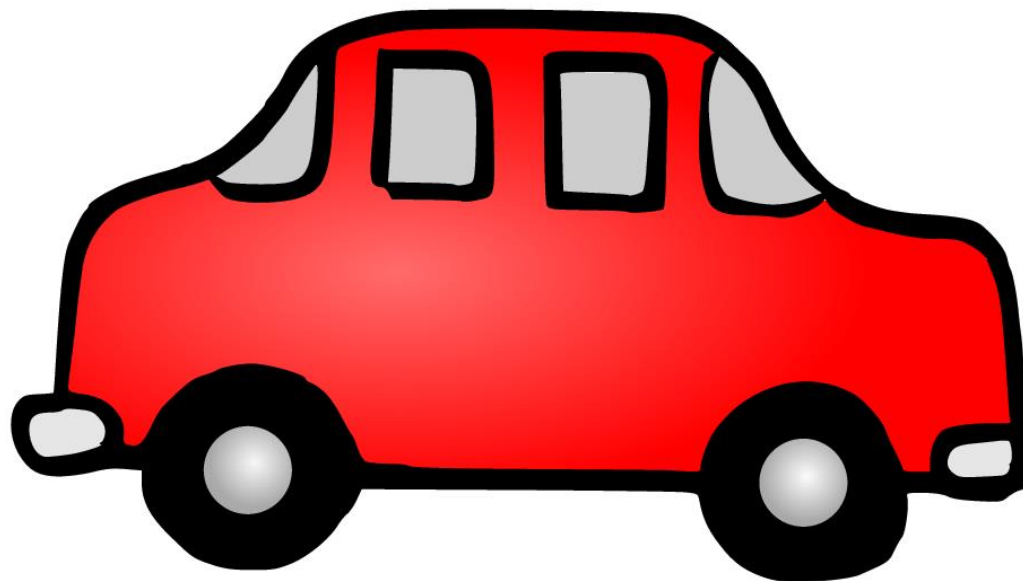
It's a special place for animals, and they work hard to protect them.



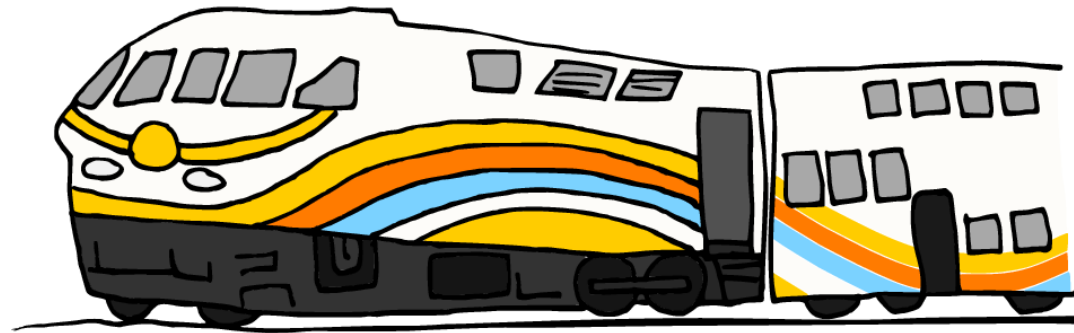
Each window will have something cool to see.

You might spot zoo animals, zookeepers, or other fun things about the zoo.

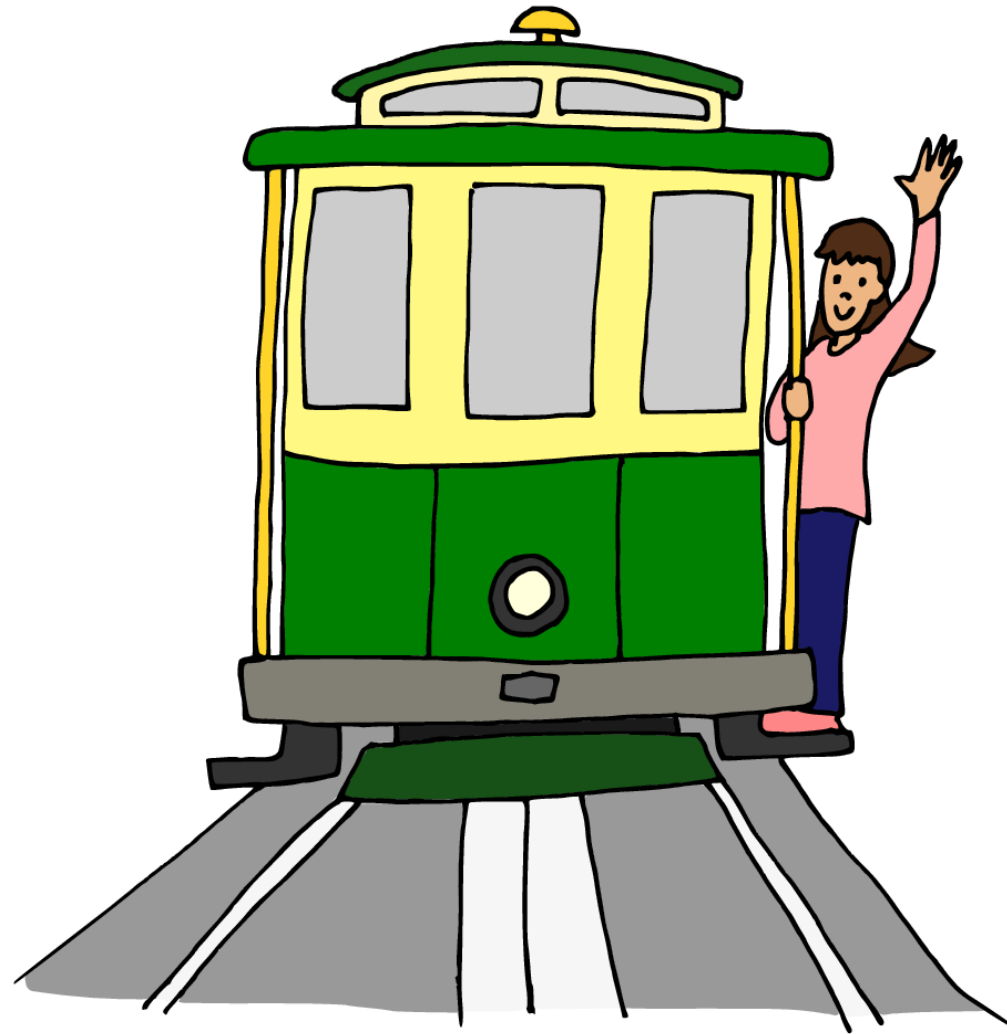
Some things might even move, such as crocodiles and elephants!

An adult will tell me how I am getting there.



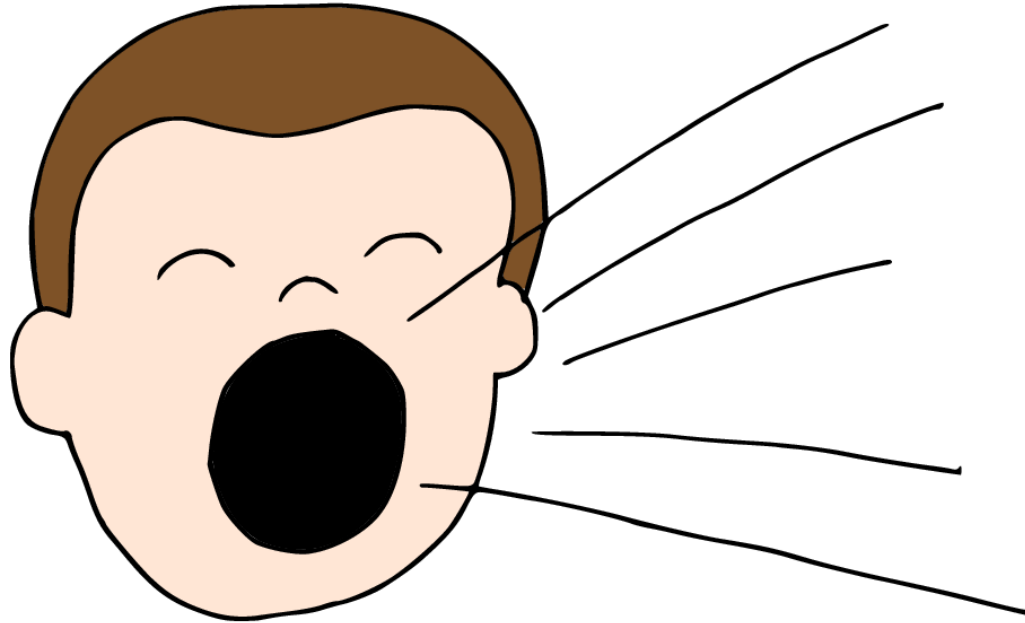
At the windows I may have to wait in a line with other people.

I can hold hands with an adult or stay close to them.



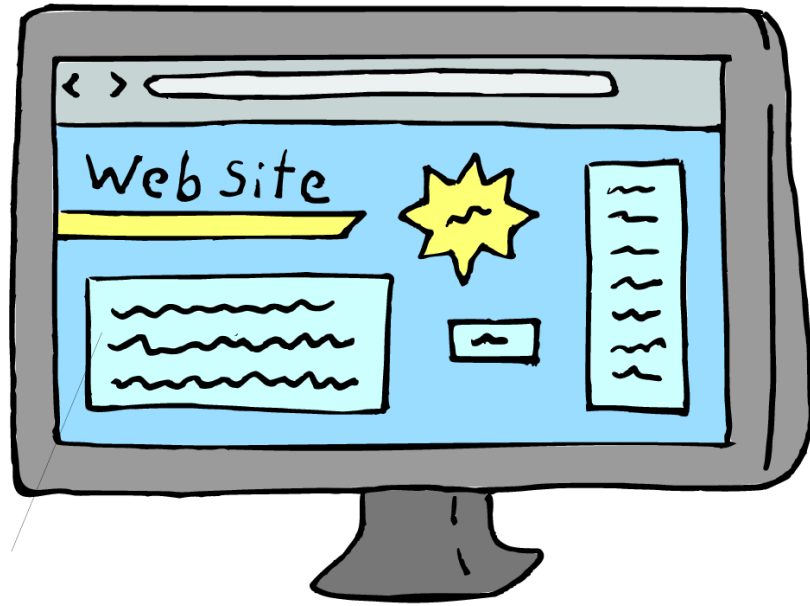
It might be noisy.
